NEW THIS SEASON - PARENT & TOT learn-to-skate program!

A program designed to allow a family member to assist in the young skater's development. This program allows the skaters to receive hands-on assistance from a family member who they know, trust and is in their cohort. Children will be taught to stand on their own, fall down & get back up and basic skating skills.

- **Sundays: 3:00 - 3:50, October 18th to December 13th, Cost: \$172 (\$80 plus 2 x \$46 Skate Canada Fee)**

CANSKATE (This season, these skaters must be able to get up on their own & move without hands-on assistance)

CanSkate participants learn the fundamentals of forward and backward skating, stopping, balance, turning, forward, and backward crosscuts, while having fun and engaging in physical activity.

- **2 Classes / week: Tuesdays & Thursdays 6:00 - 6:50, October 20th to March, Cost: 20 weeks \$340 (+ \$46 Skate Canada Fee), or 9 weeks (October 20th to December 17th) \$160 (+ \$46 Skate Canada Fee)**

- **1 Class / week: Sundays 3:00 - 3:50, October 18th to December 13th, Cost: \$90 (+ \$46 Skate Canada Fee)**



JUNIOR (CanSkate Stage 4-6)

This is a program for those skaters who have completed CanSkate Stage 3 and are preparing for the entry level of the Skate Canada STARskate program. This 20 week program runs October 18th - ice out.



INTERMEDIATE (StarSkate - Star 1)

This is a program for those skaters who have completed Stage 6 of the CanSkate program and are at the entry level of the Skate Canada STARskate program. The program includes freeskate, dance, skills and stroking lessons. This 20 week program runs October 18th - ice out.

SENIOR (Starskate - Star 2+)

This is a program for skaters who have entered the STARskate program and are working independently on freeskate, dance and skills. This 20 week program runs October 18th - ice out.
